

FAQ's on CUET 2023

1. What is NTA?
The Ministry of Education, Government of India has established the National Testing Agency (NTA) as an independent and autonomous organization for conducting efficient, transparent, and international standardized tests to assess the competence of candidates for admission to higher education institutions of the country with a mission to improve equity and quality in education.
2. What is CUET 2023?
The CUET is national level Common University Entrance Test for admission into UG Programmes in all participating autonomous colleges and universities (Constituent / Affiliated Colleges) for academic session 2023-24.
3. Is CUET online or offline test ?
It is an online Computer Based Test based on objective type MCQs.
4. How to register for CUET 2023 ?
Registration is online on the website https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/
5. Why CUET ?
It is a single examination which will provide a single window opportunity to be part of the admission process in any of the participating institutions throughout the country. Therefore, CUET will provide a common platform and equal opportunities to candidates across the country, especially those from rural and other remote areas and help establish better connect with the Universities/ Autonomous colleges for gaining higher education.
6. Is CUET free ?
No, it is not free. The fee can be submitted only online through Net Banking/Credit Card/Debit Card/UPI, or Paytm Services.
7. Can I pay the fee offline at any centre or NTA office?
No
8. What is CUET score?
It is the marks obtained by a candidate in the chosen domain/s and can be different for different domain subjects.
9. Is NEET and CUET same ?
No, they are different tests conducted by NTA separately.
10. Do I need do any kind of coaching for CUET 2023.
CUET tests the domain knowledge of 10+2 level of a student in his chosen domain subject.
11. Is CUET mandatory for admission in a degree college?
Yes, it is mandatory for all those colleges, who are part of CUET 2023. For the colleges, who are not part of CUET 2023, admission will be non-CUET based.
12. Where is the detailed information available for CUET 2023?
The details of the programmes offered by participating Universities / colleges are available on their respective websites as well as on https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/
13. Where can I find the information on scheme of examination?
For Papers, Scheme, Timing, eligibility and other information, candidates can check the Information Bulletin of CUET – 2023 available on the website: https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/ .
14. Can I submit more than one application form?
Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate. Any candidate with more than one Application Number will be treated as Unfair Means, even if found at a later stage, and strict action will be taken against that Candidate.
15. What is the last date of registration?
The Registration for Common University Entrance Test [CUET (UG) – 2023] is live since 09 February 2023 and the last date is 30 th March, 2023.
16. Who can participate in the counselling and admission process of a college?
Candidates who will be appearing in CUET - 2023 may participate in the Counselling / admission process of any University / Institution / Organization even though they have not

<p>applied for that University / Institution / Organization in the Online Application Form of CUET– 2023 but domain mapping eligibility is compulsory.</p>
<p>17. Can I get admission in a college even without CUET Score? Yes, in case that no CUET score-based candidate is available for admission, the seat/s may be filled from non CUET based candidate as per admission policy of institution.</p>
<p>18. In case the same program is offered by more than one institution, can I apply for admission in multiple institutions based on score obtained in a single domain subject ? Yes, you are eligible for seeking admission in multiple institutions, but admission will be subject to availability of seat/s and domain mapping of that institution.</p>
<p>19. Can I choose a same program from multiple institutions/colleges? Yes, a same program can be chosen from multiple institutions for admission.</p>
<p>20. If I have not chosen or selected a college at the time of registration for CUET for a particular program, but want to take admission in that college/university later. Yes, institutional choice is not fixed. Candidates who will be appearing in CUET- 2023 may participate in the Counselling / admission process of any University / Institution / Organization even though they have not applied for that University / Institution / Organization in the Online Application Form. However, the candidates must fulfil the eligibility criteria of that Program of University / Institution / Organization where they are seeking admission.</p>
<p>21. Does appearing in CUET 2023 Guarantee my admission in a college? No, mere appearance in CUET 2023 doesn't guarantee admission, but CUET score mapped to availability of seats in a particular program of an institution will decide the selection.</p>
<p>22. Will CUET score merit change from institution to institution? Yes, it will be different from institution to institution</p>
<p>23. How can I select university/college name for my chosen program/s? The names of various colleges/institutions are available in the drop-down menu, and the candidate has to choose from the available list.</p>
<p>24. How can I select the program name while registering? All the programs offered by an institution/college are available along with the 10+2 eligibility and the domain subject required for getting tested in the CUET 2023.</p>
<p>25. Within a single institution/college/university, can I choose different programs YES, you can choose as many programs as per your eligibility. However, a maximum of ten domain subjects can be chosen for a single CUET test by a candidate.</p>
<p>26. How can I check my eligibility for various programs? It is available on the respective institution's website under the admission prospectus/admission 2023</p>
<p>27. Am I eligible to pursue a degree in a college beyond the subjects I had qualified in 10+2? Yes, selecting and appearing in general test will make you eligible for seeking admission in diverse types of programs in various institutions, however, it depends on CUET merit score and the availability of seats.</p>
<p>28. What is a general test? This test will check the candidates General Knowledge, Current Affairs, General Mental Ability, Numerical Ability, Quantitative Reasoning (Simple application of basic mathematical concepts arithmetic/algebra geometry/mensuration/statistics), Logical and Analytical Reasoning.</p>
<p>29. Through general test, I will be eligible for which programs It depends which programs/courses an institution/college has mapped with the general test or reserved to offer during counselling/admission process based on the performance in the general test.</p>
<p>30. With CUET score am I eligible for admission in outside the state colleges Yes, eligibility is national</p>
<p>31. What is a domain subject? Domain subject is the subject that will decide the admission in an institution/college for a particular program.</p>

32. How many domain subjects can I chose per application form?
Ten
33. Is counselling required before or after the CUET
It will be after the CUET 2023 test is conducted and scores released.
34. When will the admission process start in the colleges?
After the completion of counselling sessions
35. How can I read the information bulletin of CUET 2023?
It is available on the NTA website.
36. Can I fill the registration form for CUET from my home?
If you have a stable internet connection, a computer or a laptop and able to keep the photograph, scanned signature ready, you can fill the registration form for CUET 2023 from the comfort of your home.
37. Is it mandatory to fill registration form at common service centre designated for the purpose?
It is not mandatory, but it will be helpful to perform registration from a common service centre.
38. Can I contact CUET helpdesk in case of difficulty or confusion in registration process

39. Is CUET score even valid for admission in next year
No, it is valid for current year only

Subject: Building awareness for Common University Entrance Test [CUET (UG)] - 2023 Examination among aspiring candidates – reg.

The Common University Entrance Test (UG) – 2023 is scheduled to be held from **21 May 2023** across India for admissions in Central and participating universities to various courses / programmes at undergraduate level. At present approximately **170 Universities / Institution / Organization / Autonomous Colleges** are participating in CUET (UG) - 2023.

The details of the programmes / courses offered by Central Universities (CUs) and other participating Universities / Organizations are available on their respective websites as well as on <https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/>

The CUET (UG) - 2023 will be conducted in **13 languages** i.e. **English, Hindi, Assamese, Bengali, Gujarati, Kannada, Malayalam, Marathi, Odia, Punjabi, Tamil, Telugu, and Urdu.**

Computer Science / Informatics Practices (308)	<p>There will be one Question Paper which will contain Two Sections and B2]. Section A will have 15 questions covering both Computer Science / Informatics Practices which will be compulsory for all. Section B1 will have 35 questions from Computer Science out of which 25 questions need to be attempted. Section B2 will have 35 questions purely from Informatics Practices out of which 25 question will be attempted.</p>
Mathematics / Mathematics (319)	<p>There will be one Question Paper which will contain Two Sections i.e. Section A and Section B [B1 and B2]. Section A will have 15 questions covering both i.e. Mathematics/Applied Mathematics which will be compulsory for all candidates. Section B1 will have 35 questions from Mathematics out of which 25 questions need to be attempted. Section B2 will have 35 questions purely from Applied Mathematics out of which 25 question will be attempted.</p>
Performing Arts (320)	<p>This paper shall have two parts: Part I is compulsory for all which will have 20 Questions. Part II shall have four sections- A, B, C, D. Each Section will have 25 Questions. Candidates are required to attempt any 20 Questions out of given 25. Candidates are required to choose any one section according to their choice.</p>

Important Instructions:

- Candidates can apply for CUET (UG) - 2023 through the "Online" mode only on the website <https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/> The Application Form in any other mode will not be accepted.
- Only one application is to be submitted by a candidate. In no circumstances, candidates will be allowed to fill more than one Application Form. Strict action will be taken, even at a later stage, against such candidates who have filled more than one Application Form.



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- iii. Candidates must strictly follow the instructions given in the Information Bulletin and on the website <https://cuet.samarth.ac.in/> Candidates not complying with the instructions shall be summarily disqualified.
- iv. Candidates must ensure that the e-mail address and Mobile Number provided in the Online Application Form are their own or Parents/Guardians only as all information/communication will be sent by NTA through e-mail on the registered e-mail address or SMS on the registered Mobile Number only.

The eligible candidates can visit the nearest Common Services Centers (CSC) (<https://www.csclocator.com/>) for filling in the Application Form. Presently more than 05 lakhs Common Services Centers (CSC) are functional across the country. (A nominal applicable fee will be charged by the Common Services Centers for filling in the registration form from the candidate).

The Public Notices issued on 02 March 2023 and 05 March 2023 regarding Help Centres for Common University Entrance Test [CUET (UG)] – 2023 established in various cities across India is annexed.

The Participating Universities, Common Services Centers, Help Centres established by NTA and City Coordinators associated with NTA are requested to build awareness about the CUET (UG) 2023 examination among the aspiring candidates in their respective areas. Candidates be made aware about the benefits of registering for the CUET (UG) Examination which will open up large number of avenues for students to get enrolled in their desired courses through a single examination in prestigious Universities/Institutions. It will provide a common platform for all aspiring applicants through a single window.

The eligible applicants be made aware that the Help Centres established by NTA across the country would be helping the candidates in filling the application form online with the help of a dedicated technical person. **This helpline service is absolutely free of cost for the candidates.** List of Help Centres is mentioned in the Annexure 2.
